



Caleb Finegan earned his doctorate (PhD, 1999) from the University of Florida with a concentration in colonial Latin American History. Dr. Finegan has been a faculty member in the Department of History since

fall 2000. He is also the director of IUP's Robert E. Cook Honors College. Most of his scholarship has focused on how parish priests who lived and worked in the Diocese of La Paz from 1680 to 1730 managed

their lives as cultural brokers between the Spanish crown and the predominantly indigenous communities they served. Dr. Finegan's current research centers on the medieval pilgrimage to Santiago de Compostela,

Spain. Every other summer, Dr. Finegan takes students to Spain to complete this 550-mile walking

pilgrimage as an active part of his research project. In 2007, Dr. Finegan was recognized as IUP's

Distinguished Faculty Member in the area of Service.
